## Treasure Hunt at the Lockwood-Mathews Mansion Museum

### Guidelines

The Treasure Hunt will run on Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2019, from 2pm to 4pm. Visitors may begin at any time and complete the tour at their own pace, and will have a choice between competing as a team or competing individually. Participants are tasked with solving the mystery of a long lost treasure using an old faded map as a guide. Treasure hunters will need to complete activities, answer questions, and solve puzzles to unlock the escalating levels of the game outside of all three buildings in Mathews Park, leading participants to the endgame inside the Mansion, including most of the first floor Period Rooms. The popular [Mister Softee](#) ice cream truck will be on premise throughout the afternoon with ice cream and refreshments available for purchase. At the end of the Treasure Hunt, there will be a Prize Drawing on the Mansion's lawn.

### **Tickets:**

- \$5 per person, recommended for ages 6 and up.
- All tickets for the Treasure Hunt include admission to the Lockwood-Mathews Mansion Museum.
- No discounts can be offered to LMMM members but your participation will serve as a donation to a great cause!

### **Rules:**

- Children must be accompanied by an adult or legal guardian at all times.
- The use of strollers will not be permitted inside the Mansion. LMMM is not responsible for strollers left unattended.
- Food and drink will not be permitted inside.
- We remind visitors to not touch the objects as they look for clues and explore the Mansion.
- Participants have until 4pm to complete the Treasure Hunt.

### **Prize Drawing:**

Finalists who find the treasure will be entered into the Prize Drawing for a chance to win prizes. Winners must be present to receive prize.
